2012 NORTHERN LIGHTS RENDEZVOUS, KENORA-JUNE 14-17, 2012

In case you hadn't heard, the **2012** *Rendezvous* will be held in Kenora, Ontario – a magnificent resort community in the heart of the Lake of the Woods.
