

This happens to be one of our best vehicle turnout events each year. In fact we are easily the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest car club in attendance behind those MG owners. Then after the show. Unfortunately my brother decided to get married that weekend and I will not be able to attend.

It seems to be a regular report out, but it's a bit late in the season to officially claim a racing news section of the Prez Release. Anyways my latest report on the Amery Airport Autocross and Speed Run is a good one. I again secured 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall with a 57.56sec run and was over a couple seconds faster than the next fastest vintage car. Needless to say the Spitfire continues to run strong. However that being said, I was only able to hit 84 MPH down the straight which is significantly off my last year

fastest run of 90MPH. I knew it wasn't running quite as well, but now I know for sure. Looks like a winter refresh will be in store. Phil also participated in the race, but slipped a few spots to 14<sup>th</sup> place vs. his 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish earlier this year. My friend Ariel ran the Audi S4 for her first race ever and clocked in a 1:06.77 shaving nearly 20 seconds off her first run to finish in 45th position and only 5 seconds slower than I ran it during an instructor run. She's nearly as competitive as I am, maybe I've found a keeper! The fastest autocross this time was Matt Cramer in his Mitsubishi Evo and the fastest down the runway was a 7.0 Liter GTO with twin turbos with a new course record of 143MPH. This race had several cars exceeding 130MPH, so it was a fast day. Next up is the Waumandee Hill Climb on the weekend of Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> (if I can get grandma to watch the boys J). Which by the way there are still several openings if you want to register your 1979 or older car.

And with mixed emotions, this next meeting will be nomination time for next year's officers. And as the By-Laws states, I must step down and let some fresh new talent take over. So please talk to your fellow members and let's get some candidates lined up for the October election meeting. We need nominations for President, Vice President, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Secretary, and Membership Chair. All other positions are volunteer based and are not voted in. So far I only know that Rick Hanson has mentioned he would like to stay on as Treasurer for second term and he has done a wonderful job and we are very fortunate to have him. Others might be interested another term as well, I just haven't heard either way yet.

Reminder: September meeting will include nominations for October elections. Many positions are due for reelection.


The meeting was adjourned so everyone could talk and kick some more tires.





Our membership year runs January 1 through December 31.


