Color Tour was the middle of October with a good turnout. The New Year's celebration had some hardy souls braving the sub zero temps.



Get out and read old Triumph **Road & Track** Road Tests! Thought you might be interested in some of **R&T's** comments. Oct. 1968 Comparison road test: Austin Healey Sprite, Datsun 1600, Fiat 850 Spider, Triumph Spitfire. "The straight-line acceleration of the Spitfire was the best of the 4 cars tested. In summing up, we would fault the Spitfire on its swing-axle rear suspension but praise it for its driving position, performance, comfortable ride, pleasant appearance and engine accessibility." "0-60 mph 13.6". April 1954, TR2 Road Test: "Side curtains feature zipper flaps for signaling and cigarette butt discarding but should a driver neglect to leave the zipper open, entrance (with top up and curtains in) is difficult because of handleless doors." "0-50 mph 8.3, 0-60 MPH 12.2". June 1956 TR3 Road Test: "The interior is snug and dry during the heaviest downpour and sliding (two panel) side windows give good viability and easy hand signaling." "The 1957 engine will run up to at least 5500 rpm occasionally without complaint even though red-lined at 5000." "The Triumph is a genuine

enthusiast dual-purpose car; very easy to drive, safe handling, a potent performer. Durable and economical. In its price class (at \$2665) it has no competition." "0-50 mph 7.8. 0-60 mph 11.4" May 1965 Triumph TR4A "The new top of the TR4-A is a great improvement over TR tops of yore. Now it is a completely modern folding top anchored at the front by two smoothly working clamps and it can be conveniently raise and lowered by one person." "Although the optional i.r.s. will add about \$125-\$150 to the delivered price of the car, we can not imagine that many buyers will chose the TR4-A without it." "Now, with the independent rear suspension and the new top, the TR4A offers Triumph drivers unprecedented amount of handling, comfort and convenience." "0-50 MPH 7.3, 0-60 MPH 10.5"

This information was taken from Road & Track Triumph Sports Cars 1953- 1967. Road & Track also has books covering Triumphs 1967-1974 and Triumphs 1974-1982.

# MEMBERSHIP NOTES

## New Members in Their Own Words

We (Mary and I) are very excited to spend some time getting to know the other Triumph owners and learn about their cars. I had some other sports cars over the years and when I graduated from college two of my closest friends purchased triumphs, one a spitfire and the other a TR-7. While I was always the passenger those were some great times cruising around with the top down by the lakes in Minneapolis. Our TR-4A was part of a collection owned by a neighbor of mine and when he told me he was selling this car I jumped at the opportunity to purchase it. The car was originally shipped to Standard Triumph in Houston in the fall of 1965. We have been tracing the history and have been able to verify the information back to 1983. We purchased the car in 2003. Our neighbor found the car in Wyoming in 1993. We have not made contact with this owner but have been told the car was driven on the street for the 2,000+ miles it shows on the odometer and then was raced for most of its early years. When we purchased the car it was in race format, stripped for weight, no dash, limited gauges, roll bar, race seats, etc. We have been told (Not completely verified but based upon the condition of the body and parts this appears to be realistic) the total mileage on the car including the racing is estimated around 12,000+ miles. The car has been in storage in a controlled environment since 1983.

In February of 2016, we decided it was time to get the car operational. Mark Brandow from Quality Coaches came over to look at the car. He brought the car to his shop and based upon the condition we really wanted to carry forward what the previous owners had started by bringing it back with a complete restoration.

With many of the parts in boxes, we really wanted to get it back to its original build. This includes the original red signal color, white top and visors, leather interior, wire wheels, etc. This is a solid axle car as well.

While the car has been off to restoration camp for almost two years now. The body is complete, drivetrain installed and interior taking shape. It is actually starting to look like a complete car. We are looking forward to driving it this summer and hoping to have it ready to show at the VTR Nationals in July.

I have attached a few pictures of the car in process. It is in the front showroom at Quality Coaches so the next time you are there stop by to take a look at the progress.


