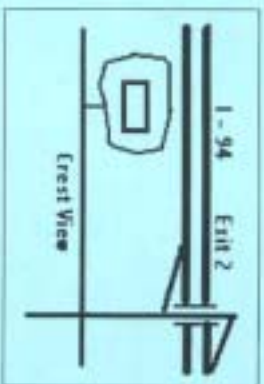

Road rallying has been a popular automotive sport ever since road builders gave drivers more than one way to get from point A to point B. Originally called "Touring", the road rally is a non-speed type of competition enjoyed by people from all walks of life, in all types of vehicles. It is a team sport with each vehicle having two occupants, one to drive, and one to help follow the course and keep them on time.

The rally is not a race. The course uses only public roads (mostly in the country). Each team is given a set of instructions that tell them where to turn, etc. The cars traverse the course at one-minute intervals. Along the course, the teams will encounter checkpoints where they must stop. The object is to arrive at each of the checkpoints at the correct time. Your arrival time will be recorded, and your score at each checkpoint is the difference between your time and the perfect time. Your scores from each checkpoint will be totaled, and the team with the lowest score (the most perfect arrival times) will be the winner.

This year, to provide more fun for the drivers and less work for the navigators, the regional rally will use the Monte Carlo format. You will be given the mileage for each checkpoint and the correct elapsed time to get there. We will also give you detailed instructions for how to get a good score. All you will really need is a good watch with a second hand or a digital watch that shows seconds.

This year the Regional Road Rally will consist of only the afternoon portion of the National event. This is intended to provide a shorter event for Regional competitors who prefer a few less miles or less time in the car. Regional registration will be in Hudson at the Wisconsin Travel Info center on Saturday at noon. If you can join us Friday for the party, you can also run the morning half of the rally for practice, or help work a checkpoint.

This rally is included in the Great Northern Historic Rallye Championship, for vehicles built prior to 1975. Historic entries will use only paved roads, and have no traps.

The Chippewa Trail National Road Rally is included in the SCCA National Rally Championship series. Contact the Rallymaster for a National entry form.
