




VTR REPORT

The time is short for those of us going to the VTR convention in Dobson, NC. Final prep plans have begun. Two weeks ago we had a get ready session at Gary Stephenson's super service facility. When I was able to use his rack, Pat Holt offered to give me a hand as I wished to check the rear diff. I am a poor service guy and had not checked it probably for years. Gary had a quart of GL-4 and the diff ate 3/4 quart as Pat discovered I had a leaky pinion seal. He topped off the overdrive and the quart was about gone. I owe you Gary.

I was happy for a week until I moved the car and found a good portion of the filled differential on the garage floor. With a week until estimated departure it was time to scramble to repair the seal. Larry Berg had just completed the same job I needed and offered that he would be sure to have it completed for me. As I had to get the car to his shop and pick it up again and go to Duluth and to Hayward things were just too hectic. I called around locally and the shop I use for domestic repairs had hired a guy a year earlier who I never knew had owned 2 TR's with one being a 74 TR6. With their tools and rack we took it apart and had the pinion seal repaired in short order. Well, not that short, but good fortune shined and the half shaft seals showed no seepage. So thanks to all and in particular Greg Thompson for tipping me off as on a past trip someone had blown their differential and had a costly tow home. Thanks also to John Myers who told me not to listen to those that told me the new 80-90w met the GL-4 spec. The bottle does say it meets 4 and the 5 spec, but Napa has GL-4 85-90w on the shelf for approx \$30 per gallon.

All of us making the journey by different routes wish we could see all of you there. Maybe next year. I will report on our route for our final newsletter in October.


August Tech Session





Our membership year runs January 1 through December 31.


