TR Monthly Meeting January 14 Really Official Minutes

The temp on Jauary fourteenth was 25°. Given the moderate weather, 35 people showed up for the January meeting. No Triumphs appeared, however.

President Terry Neuman called the meeting to order at 7:05. New members Dan and Cody introduced themselves. Each owns a '71 Spitfire, one of which needs more restoration than the other. Spitty experts in the room were pointed out to them.

In the category of old business, Terry noted tahe the club won the chapter participation award at last year's Vintage Triumph Register national convention. (The host club, in this case the Illinois Sports Owners Association, can not win this award.) Members John Myers, Joe Soucheray and Terry Mackey also won awards for their cars.

Joe Demuth reported that we have seven new members since August and wondered where these people are coming from. He received a couple dozen opinions in response to this. Next the secretary (that's me) pointed out that there were no meetings in November and December. Everyone who thought they had forgotten what happened at those meetings was glad to hear this.

Our VTR rep, Larry Sanderson, was in Florida, but Greg Thompson reported that it's only a little over a thousand miles to the 2016 national Triumph convention in Texas. And it's the first week in October so heat stroke should not be a problem.

Newsletter editor Orrin McGill said the calendar in the January issue was a paper tiger and all the dates were wrong. Could a planning group get together and figure this out? Intermarque rep Doug Burch reported that the Spring KickOff is May 14. Members approved our usual contribution to the Intermarque. Doug also pointed out that Rendezvous is June 9-12. Tech guru Roger Kraemer noted that there are openings on the tech calendar, especially for people with heated garages. Gene Kimble said he had some projects for his house on February 27.

PHOTO OF THE WEEK: TRIUMPH TRS LEMANS RACING CAR BODY RESTORED

The Triumph TRS LeMans Racing Car restored by Randy Phillippi for The Roadster Factory is back in our showroom this week. The body work and painting are finished, and the body has been refitted to the chassis with rear axle, suspensions, and brakes installed. The race number circles are painted on without the numbers. The car carried no. 28 when it raced in 1960, driven by Ninian Sanderson and Mike Rothschild, and it carried no. 27 in 1961 when Keith Ballisat and Peter Bolton drove it to 9th position overall, the best of any of the TRS cars in either year. We have already made decisions which will require no. 27 on our finished car. These were in fact made for us by Triumph, as certain modifications made for 1961 could not be reversed easily. There were certain details of the 1960 version which appeal more to me, such as the red seats, but it makes sense not to build a hybrid. Besides rebuilding the engine and gearbox, a few other details remain, including the production of a windscreen and frame, as it had been lost before this car was purchased. Fortunately, we have a perfect pattern from another TRS also owned by TRF. Randy Phillippi engineered a seat frame, but we must decide final details and have it upholstered by our friend Larry Learn. I have located the engine block in England that was fitted to this TRS when it raced at LeMans in 1961. Provided it is in usable condition, I would like to have it in the car for the sake of originality. I hope to have a Sabrina engine built in England for this project by autumn, and I hope that the gearbox will be rebuilt by Bob Jasper, a very active TR enthusiast in Southern California whom I have known for many years.

It has been a while since I have mentioned the TRS project in detail, and as it is back at TRF, I thought readers might enjoy reading this update. I have been involved in the restoration of a good many Triumphs, and predictably, this project has required a lot more time and money than the standard models with which I have been involved, TR3A, TR250, TR5, and TR6. I do think that all of the work which has been done so far is superb and, therefore, well worth the effort. When the car is finished, I have dreams of taking it to France for the Classic LeMans some year and also home to England. I don't know if I will last long enough to accomplish all that, but I will keep working in that direction.



2016 Pre-Rendezvous Reconnoitre

Hosted by "Chad and Dad"

The 2016 Pre-Rendezvous Reconnoitre is a drive through Northwestern Ontario, Northeastern Minnesota, and Southeastern Manitoba. The tour will leave Winnipeg, MB on June 4th and follow a clockwise route, finally arriving in Kenora, ON on June 9th in time for the start of the 2016 Sunset Country Rendezvous. The trip will pass through Fort Francis, ON; Thunder



Bay, ON; Duluth, MN; International Falls, MN; Winnipeg, MB; and finally Kenora, ON.

For anyone worried about this being some kind of race or high-pressure rally, rest easy. This is simply an enjoyable drive with fellow British Car enthusiasts. As was evident during the excellent Rendezvous Rallye Superieur organized by Andy Lindberg last year, each day everyone was able to find a group of cars to travel with and drive at their own pace. Drive as fast or as slow as you want. Any British car would have no trouble keeping up.

Where possible, this year's route was chosen using suggestions for motorcycle tours, as they tend to travel scenic highways with little other traffic. The day from Duluth to International Falls is about 30% on roads described as "curvy, hilly, more challenging paved roadways". Each day's distance varies, but on average the tour will cover ~375km/235miles daily. This gives plenty of time for leisurely starts in the morning, relaxed lunches, and early arrivals at the day's destination with stops for sightseeing along the way. Even with the occasional road side tech session, no one should ever feel rushed. Total distance covered for all 6 days would be ~2260km/1400miles.

While we would love to have everyone join the drive from the start, we know that for many it will make more sense to join the tour along the route. The route was planned with this in mind, so if one wants to join in Thunder Bay, or Duluth, or any other point, feel free. For people in Winnipeg, if you don't want to do the entire drive it would still be great to have you join on the final day for the trip from Winnipeg to Kenora.

There is no cost to register for the tour. You will pay for your own food along the way, as well as your lodging each night. Once we have an idea of how many people are going to participate, arrangements will be made for a block of rooms at a nice, but inexpensive, hotel for each night. That list will be provided so that each participant can make their own room reservations.

Join after September 1st and enjoy full membership benefits through the remainder of the current year and the entire next year.



Remember, if you joined the club after September 1 your dues are good for 2016.


