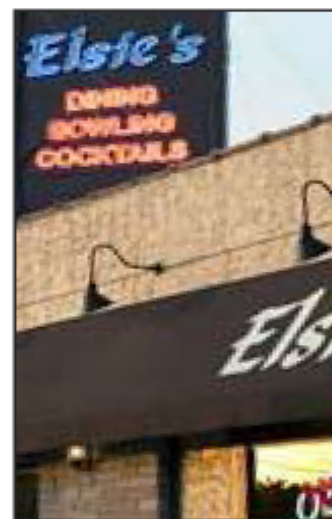
Everyone is running unopposed so the election should be really quick!

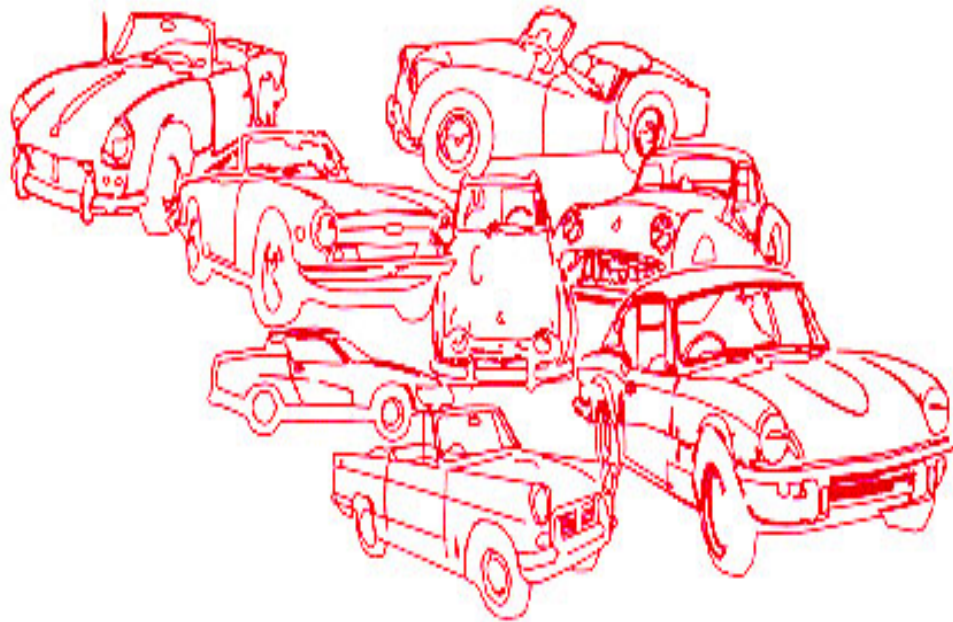
