2018 VTR (Vintage Triumph Register) National Convention.

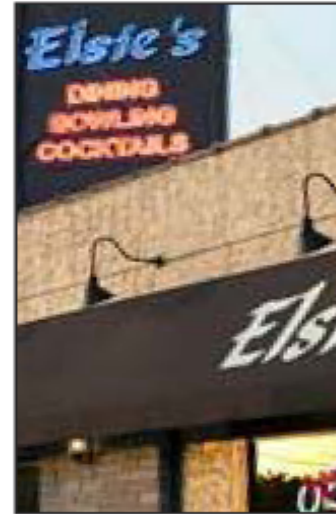

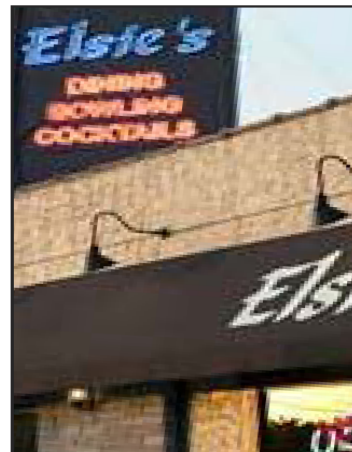
