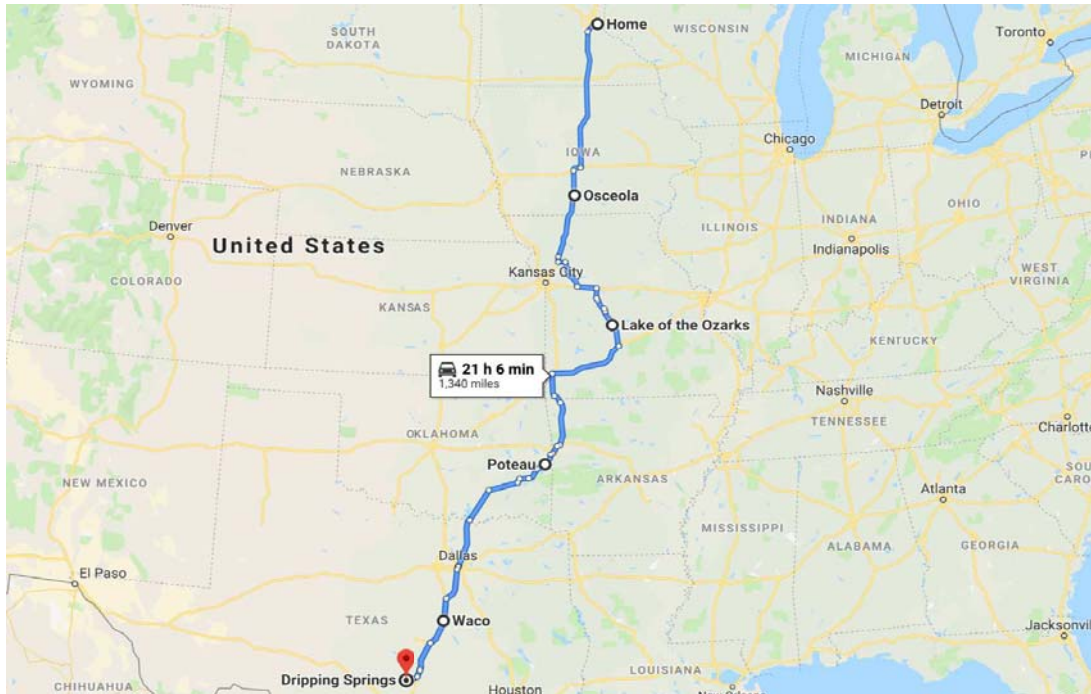

As I write this, we are only 11 days from leaving for the VTR National in Texas. The route has been planned for a while with hotels set too. The third day we will ride the ridges of the beautiful mountains of Arkansas. Our last big travel day leaves us in the hot town of Waco Texas to visit all things “Fixer-Upper”.

Parts get to my door the 29<sup>th</sup> some time, so by the time you read this I hope it is back on the road.

On another note, this will be the last VTR report I will be writing. I am not relinquishing the VTR liaison post but Carol and I will be taking over the newsletter from Orrin in the new year and I will be expanding the subjects I write about. So look for a new look and some new subjects in the new year.

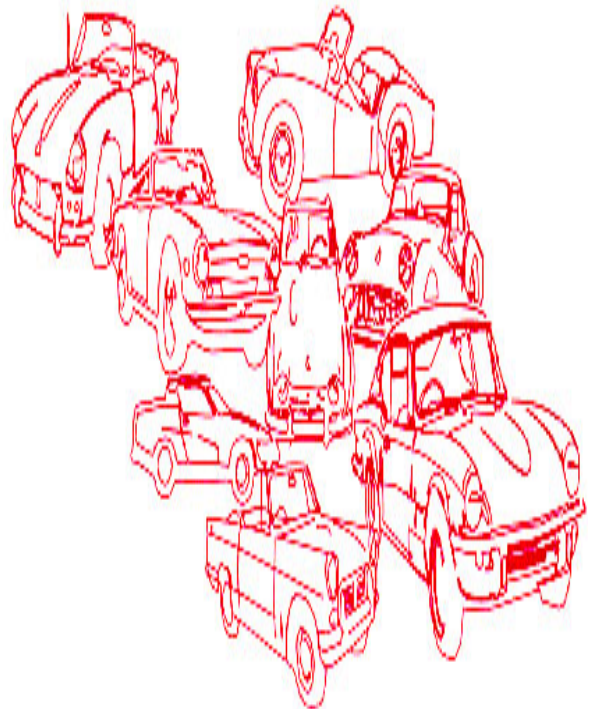
